Case Writer Reflects

I have worked with Prof. Indranil Bose and Prof. Preetam Basu in developing a case on CRISIL, the credit rating company. Writing this case involved very active collaboration with the professors, in terms of collecting information, analyzing the same and writing and editing the narrative.

The CRISIL case involved both primary and secondary research. We had to read a lot of material available about CRISIL, including a book written about the company. Using this background information, we then met senior CRISIL executives including their CEO in their Mumbai Head Office.
